

DAY OF CARING FAQ SHEET

On May 17th, United Way of Greater Stark County is having its 26th Annual Day of Caring event. Each year, United Way matches volunteer teams from workplaces across the community with nonprofit agencies and schools for Day of Caring projects. Volunteer teams perform tasks for organizations that otherwise would not have the manpower to complete the work. Projects include things like landscaping, painting, general cleaning, building or sorting donations, just to name a few! Day of Caring is an opportunity for coworkers to gather outside the workplace and build teamwork and camaraderie while giving back to our community.

This year, **732 volunteers** participating from **39 different companies or organizations** for a grand total of **3,488 hours** in the community.

Volunteers are working on 42 different projects at 40 different organizations or schools.
